OPENING CEREMONY OF THE UNITED NATIONS HOUSE IN DIAMNIADIO, SENEGAL, ON THURSDAY THE 23th OF NOVEMBER

Designed by Wilmotte & Associés Architectes, the United Nations House in Diamniadio (a subdivision of Dakar, Senegal) brings together the 34 agencies, funds and programmes of the United Nations system already present in Senegal in an iconic 60,000 m² building.

The aim of this emblematic building is to illustrate the union of the agencies, but also their independence and their influence on a national and regional scale. Eco-responsible and sustainable, the project is reminiscent of a water wheel, symbolising the influence of the institution across the region and the convergence of expertises. This large circular volume unfurls seven wings of equal size, opening onto the city and organising a central space designed as a unifying space hosting the official functions as well as a large agora.

The surrounding landscape provides a link between this unusual form and the urban plan. The planting follows the radiating



layout of the project, integrating the forms into the vast landscaped park. The garden will be the link between the local ground and the international sphere.

The creation of the new UN House in Diamniadio is part of the UN's "From Blue to Green" approach, in other words "United in Action" and "greener operations": energy management (solar panels + equipment efficiency), water management (saving drinking water + wastewater treatment + wastewater recovery), waste management (collection system / sorting and recycling procedure), quality of the indoor environment (hygrothermal & visual comfort / air quality), etc.

Like its programm, the construction of the United Nations House has a strong international dimension. It's the result of a public-private partnership between the State of Senegal, which is heavily involved in the project, and Envol Partenariats SN, the building is the culmination of the collective work of Senegalese, Chinese, Turkish, Spanish and French design offices, contractors and architects, all working together for the benefit of future international users.
